## **2019 NPA Fluke Tournament Rules**

**Welcome to the 2019 NPA Tournament. This is a charity based event which promotes friendly competition on a day to enjoy fishing with friends and family. The tournament board places trust in every participant to follow and acknowledge the rules as set forth. Best of luck!**

- . 1) Only one (1) legal size Fluke (Summer Flounder- according to NYS DEC Regulations) per registrant may be weighed in.
- . 2) All weighed in fish must be caught in Long Island waters (all waters surrounding Long Island).
- . 3) All weighed in fish must be caught by a registered tournament angler.
- . 4) All weighed in fish must be caught on rod and reel.
- . 5) All weighed in fish must be caught during the hours of the tournament (sunrise to 4PM).
- . 6) All weighed in fish must be checked in at the designated check in location by 4 PM.
- . 7) Weighing of fish will begin at approximately 3 PM.
- . 8) All fish will be weighed by the NPA weigh in committee on a digital scale provided by the NPA.
- . 9) An official scale reading will be recorded after a minimum time of 5 seconds on the scale.
- . 10) If any scale number value does not remain stable after 5 seconds, the recorded weight will include the highest displayed value.
- . 11) The NPA weigh in committee will make all final determinations of official weights.

- . 12) Frozen fish, or fish that have been altered in any way will be disqualified/excluded.
- . 13) The NPA weigh in committee will make all final determinations regarding disqualifications.
- . 14) In the event of a two way tie within a prize category, the prize money for that category will be added to the prize money for the following category and the total will be split evenly among the tied anglers. In the highly unlikely event of a three way or more tie in any category, the prize money for the tied category will be combined with all remaining lower prize categories and split evenly between the anglers. In this case, no additional prizes will be awarded.
- . 15) The tournament will be held regardless of weather conditions. Each angler is responsible to make their own determination as to the safety of fishing on the day of the tournament, The NPA assumes no liability for any decisions made by any participants.
- . 16) All entry fees are non-refundable.
